Reconnect provides participants with mentoring to help them find the right course that suits their strengths, interests and career aspirations. Our ongoing support is designed to help participants complete their studies to gain employment.

What Reconnect provides participants

- ✓ Weekly to fortnightly mentoring, including outreach
- ✓ Assistance to enrol and complete accredited training
- ✓ Motivation, confidence and self-esteem building
- ✓ Group training, work experience and access to other services
- ✓ Up to 18 months support

Eligibility

17 - 19 year old

- ✓ Not completed Year 12 or equivalent (Cert II or above)
- ✓ Not currently studying
- ✓ Not in full-time employment

OR

20 - 64 year old

- ✓ Not completed Year 12 or equivalent (Cert II or above)
- ✓ Unemployed for more than 12 months
- ✓ Not in full-time employment
